## Basketweaving with Anne Coleman

**Big, Bigger and Biggest:** This will be a ribbed basket weaving workshop that will cover all aspects of the Traditional Appalachian ribbed basket. Participants will construct and weave 3 large baskets using hardwood hoops, flat ribs and reed weaving. Hoops will be 8" to 18" in diameter with both wide and narrow options for the traditional look. Each participant will make 3 large ribbed baskets in graduating sizes. Learn the 'Folded Square' lashing and have the option of having this braided, learn both primary and secondary rib placement, learn Anne's easy method of 'turning back' and decorative weaving around the hoops. All of this can be covered in class with staining and finishing techniques discussed. There will be optional instructional material for these and other ribbed baskets and techniques. **Supplies in the amount of \$8.00, per basket, payable to the instructor.**

**Woven Chalice:** This hand turned pedestal base will be done in a choice of Kentucky hardwoods, sizes and styles. Weaving will be in cane. **Supplies in the amount of \$8.00 payable to the instructor.** Participants also need to bring an empty 16 ounce Cool-Whip container.

**Oval Wooden Bottom Basket/Anne's Acronyms:**

Start with an oak oval and weave continuously to create a medium size 'Nantucket Look' basket woven with reed. Or choose to upgrade and make Anne's famous Acronyms bag with the optional Monogramming. **Supplies start in the amount of \$8.00 and are payable to the instructor.**

**Remembering the Past (Beginner):** Weave a rectangular basket with a Cherry rolling pin as the handle. The cherry rolling pin is crafted by a local woodworker. The basket has a woven bottom and the rolling pin is attached when lashing with cane. **Supplies in the amount of \$10.00 payable to the instructor at the beginning of class. Fri. Sept. 4 / 9am–1pm**

**It's a Cutie (Beginner):** Woven on a 2 x 9 rectangular slotted base and uses a round top notched handle. A simple weave basket with dyed reed added. Choose your color of dye reed accents and weave your own pattern to make your one of a kind. This is a great little basket to use anywhere in the house from the bathroom to the office to the kitchen or even makes a great gift. **Supplies in the amount of \$10.00 payable to the instructor at the beginning of class. Fri. Sept. 18 / 9am–1pm**

**Autumn Door Basket (Beginner):** Basket is woven on a tall “D” handle. It can either hang on your door, door knob or on your wall to decorate for the fall season. You will weave with some fall colored dyed reed or you can choose a more neutral color to change decorations for different seasons. A fall decoration is included. **Supplies in the amount of \$13.00 payable to the instructor at the beginning of class. Fri. Oct. 2 / 9am–1pm**

**Bean Pot (Beginner):** A pot bellied bean pot basket with cats head feet. You will learn an easy method to weave a cat's head bottom. It will be woven in either smoked reed or multi-colored dyed reed. Uses a wire bean pot handle. **Supplies in the amount of \$10.00 payable to the instructor at the beginning of class. Fri. Oct. 16 / 9am–1pm**

**Kitchen Basket (Beginner):** You will have your choice to weave one of three different style baskets to use in your kitchen or that would make a wonderful gift. Choices will be either a tall utensil basket, a shorter rectangular basket to hold dish clothes or cookbooks or a recipe card basket. Each will use small rolling pins with painted ends as the handles. The recipe basket will have a slot in the handle to hold your recipe. **Supplies in the amount of \$13.00 payable to the instructor at the beginning of class. Fri. Oct. 23 / 9am–1pm**

**Jingle Bells Card Basket (Beginner):** Get ready for the Holidays! Store and display your holiday Cards in this easy and fun to weave basket. It measures approximately 8 x 5 and is accented with your choice of red or green dyed reed. It is finished off with jingle bells attached to the rim. A handle can be added for a small additional fee if you wish but is not necessary. **Supplies in the amount of \$10.00 payable to the instructor at the beginning of class. Fri. Nov. 6 / 9am–1pm**

**Server Basket (Beginner):** The basic server basket will be woven on a wooden base, accented with dyed reed and lashed with cane. For an additional cost you will have the options to add a plastic insert to make the basket into a relish tray, a glass pie dish and or bushel handles to make this a multi-functional basket. **Supplies in the amount of \$13.00 payable to the instructor at the beginning of class. Fri. Dec. 11 / 9am–1pm**
