**OSHA # 501 Trainer Course
in OSHA Standards for General Industry**

This course is designed for personnel interested in teaching the 10 and 30-hour general industry safety and health outreach program to their employees and other interested groups. Special emphasis is placed on those topics that are required in the 10 and 30-hour programs as well as on those most hazardous, using the OSHA standards as a guide.

Participants are briefed on effective instructional approaches and the effective use of visual aids and handouts, and engage in practice teaching modules—with feedback.

Upon successful course completion, the student will receive an OSHA Training Institute Education Center certificate of completion as an "Outreach Trainer"—good for 4 years.

Prerequisites for this class are OSHA # 511 or equivalent and 5 years of general industry safety experience.

Bill Abney will serve as the lead instructor. Bill is Course Chair for the OSHA 501 at EKU & has over 30 years in safety education, specializing in safety management & research, fire, explosives, & hazardous materials.
