The College of Justice & Safety (CJS) and Continuing Education & Outreach (CE&O) at Eastern Kentucky University (EKU) will be sponsoring a training-for-trainers program for individuals interested in the area of social intelligence (SI). The eighty hour curriculum will be presented by Dr. Steve Sampson.

The two (forty hour) training sessions will be held on the EKU campus in Richmond during December 1-5, 2008 and February 2-6, 2009. Individuals selected to participate in the program will be reimbursed for travel, lodging and meals. EKU will provide stipends to cover the cost of the two training sessions.

Individuals interested in applying for the 80 hour Social Intelligence Training for Trainers should submit a letter of introduction accompanied by a vita and/or resume. Preference will be given to teams of 2-3 applicants who will commit to training the curriculum for their agencies and/or EKU after the training is complete. A Bachelors Degree is required and Masters Degree is preferred.
